## **Big inconveniences in transportation in the U.S. East Coast caused by the Hurricane Sandy**

Dear Customer,

due to the Hurricane Sandy on the east coast of Usa, the states of Maryland, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, Virginia, Washington DC and the coastal counties of North Carolina have declared a state of emergency. The airlines have canceled flights today's long-haul in and out the airports of the East Coast, including New York, Philadelphia, Baltimore, Newark, Washington and Boston. Train local service has been delayed and canceled.

In New York, where JFK airport is closed, also underground, buses and trains have stopped. Local transport also have been stopped in Washington DC, Philadelphia and the state of New Jersey. Other temporary closures are expected in the coming hours of airports in the areas affected by the disruption. It is possible that the discomfort may continue for a few days along with the evolution of the hurricane.

We invite interested travelers to monitor the situation - in constant evolution - on the websites of the airports mentioned above, the local media and contact your CWT office reference for any rebooking and/or cancellations.
