## **Updating on air sector strikes**

We would inform you about several strikes forecasted for next weeks in the air sector:

- the strike of **Meridiana Fly** pilots forecasted for the 3<sup>rd</sup> May (4 hours: from 10 a.m. to 14 p.m.) is **cancelled**, so that the airline company will operate regularly;
- the strike of **Sea Spa and Sea Handling** personnel at Milan Linate and Milan Malpensa airports (24 hours) forecasted for 3<sup>rd</sup> May is **postponed to the 14<sup>th</sup> may**;
- the strike of flight assistants of **Blue Panorama for 3^{rd} May** (4 hours: from 10 a.m. to 14 p.m.) is **confirmed**.

We would remind you also about other strikes forecasted in the air sector for the  ${\bf 14}^{th}$  May:

- flight assistants of **Easy Jet**, 4 hours: from 10 a.m. to 14 p.m.;
- **Sea Spa and Sea Handling** personnel at **Milan Linate and Milan Malpensa** airports, 24 hours (Usb, Filt-Cgil, Filt-Cisl, Uil e Ugl, Flai-Ts unions);
- crew and pilots **Alitalia CAI** (Alitalia Cityliner included), 24 hours.

We would lastly inform you that at the **Vnukovo Moscow Airport** delays are likely at 3<sup>rd</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> May due to rehearsals of Air Force for Victory Parade.
