Business meetings can increase companies' profits

Face-to-face meetings with customers, or potential, can increase, even in a consistent way, the profits of companies. So they think the two thousand managers interviewed to perform the research Business Meetings in a Modern World, sponsored by Intercontinental Hotel Group (in five key markets: UK, USA, UAE, China and India). Nearly half (47%) of business men and woman surveyed believe they had lost a contract or client simply because they didn't have enough face-to-face meetings, which resulted in the estimated yearly revenue loss of 24%. 81% state that face-to-face meetings are better for building long-term trust and ensuring strong client relationships; in particular, starting a new business relationship (57%), finalising a deal (54%) and contract negotiation (53%) are the top subjects respondents prefer to discuss face-to-face. According to the findings in the report, not only how a business meeting is conducted, but also when, could change the outcome. Tuesday morning is identified as the optimum time for a successful face-to-face meeting in the UK and US, while Monday mornings are considered the best time of the week for productive meetings in China, India and UAE. One in two respondents believes that it may be useful for the success of a meeting, strengthen the contact on social media - especially Facebook (used by 48%) and LinkedIn (42%).

ALERT A French union representing Lufthansa personnel at Paris's Roissy-Charles de Gaulle International Airport has called for a series of strikes beginning today, November 20. A walkout will take place this evening from 5:00 pm until 7:00 pm (local time). Walkouts will also take place daily November 21-23 from 7:00 am until 9:00 am and again from 5:00 pm until 7:00 pm (local time). A full day strike is being planned for Sunday, November 24. As a result of this industrial action, disruptions to Lufthansa flights in and out of Paris-CDG (delays, cancellations) are to be anticipated over the coming days. More info on the Airport website.

ALERT Singapore Airlines has extended the limits of free baggage allowance. From 15th November, customers are entitled to 10 kg more, for all classes of travel. In particular, the allowance is 50 kg if they fly in Suites and First Class, Business Class 40 kg and 30 kg in Economy Class. For flights to and from the United States, where Singapore apply a per-piece allowance, customers traveling in Suites, First Class and Business Class will be entitled to two pieces up to 32 kg each one, compared to the previously 23 kg.
