#InsiemepergliSDG (TogetherfortheSDGs) is the campaign promoted by the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation, together with the partners FAO, UN SDG Action Campaign, CHIEAM Bari, and Save the Children to enhance the best local experiences that each city creates for the implementation of the UN Sustainable Development Goals. The initiative offers training and teaching activities, participatory politics, active citizenship and develops partnerships with local media to promote the messages of the campaign. Since October 2020, the initiative has touched - together with its installations, which raise awareness of young people and families on the role that each one can play for the SDGs - Bari, Teramo, Rome, Prato, Cremona, Milan, Siena, Brescia, and Bergamo. In 2023 the Campaign goes to Naples and Trieste, highlighting the role of Italian port cities as windows on the Mediterranean.

The stage of Trieste is dedicated to the important contribution that the city offers to the SDGs by hosting a global excellence, the international scientific hub. The hub brings together prestigious research and training bodies dedicated in particular to guaranteeing researchers from the Countries of the Global South the access to the best scientific knowledge and technologies that have a major impact on health, environment, and food security of the Countries of origin.
